Cat Owner Questionnaire

Appears forgetful			
Is less interested in food			
Is eating more			
Has changed sleeping places e.g. to the floor or low surfaces			
Is drinking more			
Has vomiting and/or diarrhoea on occasions			
Has breathing difficulties on occasion (e.g. laboured breathing, breathing with the mouth open)			
Has a lump on the body			
Has smelly breath			
Can't see as well as they used to be able to			
Can't hear as well as they used to be able to			
Is more talkative/noisy than they used to be
